

## Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup>

# Ready to Use Histological Tissue Fixative

#### Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup>, The product and its purpose:

Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> is a low-hazard Histological tissue fixative specially formulated without hazardous Picric Acid and Formaldehyde as a replacement for traditional Bouin's Fluid. Bouin's 2000 will fix and mordant tissue in the same manner as traditional Bouins Fluid with no change of procedure required. Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> is intended for In Vitro Diagnostic use. Active ingredients include; Glyoxal (<30%), Ethanol (<10%), and Zinc Chloride (<10%).

### Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup>, Instructions for use:

Use Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> as you would traditional Bouin's Fluid. When used as a post-fixative for trichrome stains, some minor adjustments are necessary. For best results treat sections overnight at room temperature. If overnight treatment is not practical, heat Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> in a waterbath and incubate sections for 90 minutes at 60 C. Rinse sections for 2 to 3 minutes in warm running water before proceeding to the next step in the stain procedure. As with traditional Bouin's Fluid, tissue should not be left in Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> for longer than 48 hours. Red blood cells may be lysed due to the acidic nature of Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup>.

#### **Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> Storage and Stability:**

Bouin's 2000<sup>TM</sup> should be stored at 15-30 C and is stable under normal laboratory conditions. See product label for shelf life.
